Eileen Gray (1878 – 1986). This Irish artist was one of the pioneers who created what we now call modern design during the 1920s and 1930s. The lone women in this pioneering Valhalla, her name is pronounced in the same breath as Le Corbusier, Mies van der Rohe and Marcel Breuer. Her tubular steel furniture was revolutionary in its day, and is now accepted as classic. In the second stage of her creative career, Eileen Gray switched to architecture and continued producing masterpieces. Her career culminated in 1972 with her appointment by the Royal Society of Art in London, as Royal Designer to Industry. Eileen Gray first rose to prominence as an architect at the age of 48. At Roquebrune, on the Cote d'Azur, she built an ideal home for herself and friend Jean Badovici. The villa, completed from 1926 to 1929, was praised as a masterpiece of Architectural avant-garde, and stands today as a monument to Eileen Gray's modernist vision. Gray's legendary Adjustable Table E1027 was added to the permanent collection of the Museum of Modern Art, New York, in 1976
